Welcome to Baudette, Minnesota!

Known as the ***“Walleye Capital of the World,”*** the City of Baudette is an attractive community of 976 residents located within Lake of the Woods County, an area known for its year-round fishing and other outdoor activities. Baudette is home to many fine businesses, specialty shops, restaurants, hotels, and resorts who are able to meet the needs of residents and travelers alike. One popular attraction in Baudette is Willie the Walleye. He turned 50 years old in 2009, and the City welcomed a brand new fiberglass replica in 2018. Each year in June, the City of Baudette celebrates his birthday with *“Willie Walleye Day,”* a fun-filled day the entire community and its many visitors participate in.

The City maintains three beautiful municipal parks - Timber Mill Community Park, Peace Park (enables you to get a view of Canada and the International Bridge), and Bay Front Park (Bay Park is home of Willie Walleye.) The River is home to a wide variety of wildlife, and activities.



The Utility Department

The City of Baudette provides electric, water, sewer, and refuse service to its customers.

Electricity – The City of Baudette is one of 12-city members of the Northern Municipal Power Agency.

Water – The City of Baudette provides drinking water to its residents from a groundwater source: one well ranging from 101 to 151 feet deep draw water from the Quaternary Buried Artesian aquifer. The average daily capacity is 185,000 gallons with the highest daily capacity at 372,000 gallons.

Sewer – The City of Baudette’s sanitary sewer system consists of both gravity and force mains, seven lift stations, and a three-cell stabilization pond system. The facility has a controlled discharge to the Rainy River and is designed to treat an average wet weather flow of 266,000 gallons per day. Primary cells 1 and 2 have surface areas of approximately 24 acres and 8.3 acres, respectively, at an operating depth of 2.5 feet. The secondary cell has a surface area of 15.6 acres at an operating depth of 3.4 feet. The pond system has the total storage capacity of 56,400,000 gallons and is designed to provide a total detention time of 212 days.

Refuse – The City contracts with Walleye Capital Sanitation for weekly refuse pick-up.

Position Summary

The Utility Superintendent performs professional work supervising the operations of city utilities and staff, assuring that systems are operating in an effective, safe, and fiscally responsible manner, conducting training, coordinating maintenance activities, responding to emergencies, and related work as apparent or assigned. Work is performed under the general direction of the City Council. Departmental supervision is exercised over five personnel within the department. This position is not part of the on-call rotation.

Education, Experience, and Licensing Requirements

High school diploma or GED and considerable experience working in city utilities, or an equivalent combination of education and experience. MN Class D Water and Wastewater license within one (1) year and valid commercial driver’s license in the State of Minnesota are required.
